The Fire Department has some new equipment. The new Masmo RAD-57C portable Carbon Monoxide oximeters are the latest pieces of equipment in the Fire Department’s medical arsenal. These oximeters were received through a grant given to the department by Firehouse Subs. The grant written by Captain Shawn Engelman was awarded to the department at a ceremony on March 3, 2009, at Firehouse Subs in West Ashley. This equipment will allow firefighters to determine carbon monoxide levels in a patient’s blood on the scene. This will not only allow firefighters to treat the public but may also provide critical information to medical personnel should a firefighter suffer smoke inhalation themselves. We would like to thank Firehouse Subs and Kevin Hatton, who is the franchise owner in Charleston, for this excellent equipment. Please stop by the James Island Public Service District Fire Station on Camp Road to see the new equipment and stop by and grab a sub from Firehouse Subs located at 1836 Ashley River Road, near Total Wine - you will not be disappointed!
