## WASTEWATER RATE INCREASE

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, the JIPSD Commission approved an increase in wastewater rates for sewer customers. This is the first rate increase the District has had since 1994.

Rates for PSD residents will increase an average of 4.6 percent, while rates for customers living outside the District will increase 69.9 percent. The new rates will become effective April 1<sup>st</sup> and will be reflected in your June bill.

These rate increases are needed to maintain and upgrade our wastewater system. But much of the increase is needed to pay for relocating sewer lines affected by road and bridge projects initiated by other government agencies.

### Reminder: House Address Display

South Carolina State Law (23-47-60) requires that residents display the address of the dwelling so that it is visible from the street, using numbers at least three inches (3") high. Reflective numbers four inches (4") in height are recommended and encouraged. The Post Office also requires correct and easily readable numbers on the mailbox. This numbering system is essential for delivery of mail and for rapid dispatch of emergency aid including fire, police and EMS.
