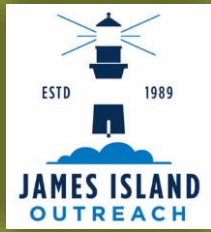

Beginning July 1, 2020, we will be re-opening our offices/lobby and are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure a safe, sanitized and clean environment. Also, beginning July 1, 2020, we will be operating under new office hours. Our new hours will be Monday – Thursday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Our on-line payment portal remains available 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

## Wastewater Information and Notices

The District’s mission is to minimize rate increases while continuing to maximize high quality, environmentally safe wastewater services. However, increased operating costs and capital projects have caused us to review the current wastewater rates to meet the needs of the system moving forward. Some major projects, both underway and in the next few years, are needed to replace failing infrastructure while others have been initiated by new debt service obligations and increased energy, labor cost, fuel and chemical cost.

On January 27, 2020, the District’s Commission voted to adjust the current rates and rate structure of the JIPSD which is to take effect July 1, 2020. Please find a breakdown of our monthly base and user charges below:

SEWER RATES	FROM	TO
Base Charge	\$17.58	\$18.40
Volume Charge (per ccf)	\$5.24	\$5.54
Residential Cap (16 ccfs) *	\$101.42	\$107.04
Non Metered Residents	\$54.05	\$56.83

\* Multiple properties on one meter are considered commercial properties and therefore are not capped at 16 ccfs. \*
