

Clark's Point Sewer Project Update | June 25, 2025



A crew is currently laying new pipeline along Taliaferro. Once the pipe installation is complete, it will go through a pressure test to ensure its stability and safety. After successful testing, the crew will

need to dig the trench again - approximately 3 feet deep and 4 feet wide - to backfill it with flowable fill, a sand and concrete mixture designed to provide stable support. This process also includes patching any street damage or potholes caused during the installation, using the same flowable fill material.

A second crew is also active on Taliaferro, focusing on patching potholes and surface damage. These repairs are being carried out at the same time as pipeline installation to minimize disruption and speed up the overall timeline.

A third crew is progressing with sewer line installation up Julian Clarke and continuing toward Relyea.

A fourth crew is managing site cleanup and performing the necessary pressure tests on newly installed pipeline sections. These steps are vital for verifying that everything meets safety standards before the final restoration.

Traffic control personnel are stationed at the intersection of Targrave and Julian Clarke to ensure safety for both workers and the public. Due to the ongoing heat wave, our traffic control staff may need to remain in shaded areas for health and safety reasons. Please be patient with them.

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
