Spring Cleanup

As you prepare for spring cleanup, please see important information on debris separation and ordinance allowances below:

- 1) All items must be curbside no later than 6AM on your pickup day.
- 2) If you have hired a contractor to work on your property and/or clear your debris, whether for man-made materials or yard debris, it is the contractor's and/or homeowner's responsibility for hauling it away.
- 3) All electronics and hazardous waste, such as TVs, batteries, paint, compressed gas, etc. should be brought to the Charleston County Convenience Center at 1716 Signal Point Road on James Island during their manned hours (Tu-Sa 10am 6pm).

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

- Must be in JIPSD roll-cart
- Garbage placed on top of or next to roll-cart may not be collected
- Additional carts are available for purchase if needed



YARD DEBRIS

- Branches can be no longer than 6'
- Small clippings/trimmings must be bagged
- Ordinance pile limit is 4'x5'x15'
- Call before placing large stumps or excess tree debris at the curb



MAN-MADE MATERIALS

- Remove food and doors from large appliances
- Stack wood and/or construction materials separately
- Box or bag smaller items
- Tape glass and mirrors to prevent shattering
