

Sewer Rate Increase

Effective July 1, 2017, the James Island Public Service District will be implementing the second phase of a rate increase that was approved during last year's budget. The James Island Public Service District has had several on-going unfunded State and County mandated projects totaling, \$3,121,190 which has forced us to raise our rates. The cost to operate and maintain our wastewater system costs more each year. When we maintain our system, we are also protecting our environment and the health of our island.
